Representing data in charts are called Smart Charts.

Different types of Smart Charts

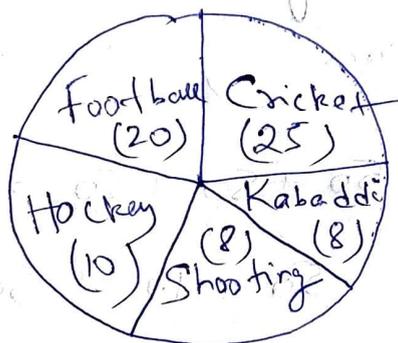
1) Tally Marks - Tally marks are drawn using vertical lines and one oblique line to mark a set of 5 and the process continues.

1 - I , 2 - II , 3 - III , 4 - IIII , 5 - IIT
6 - IIT I , 7 - IIT II , 8 - IIT III

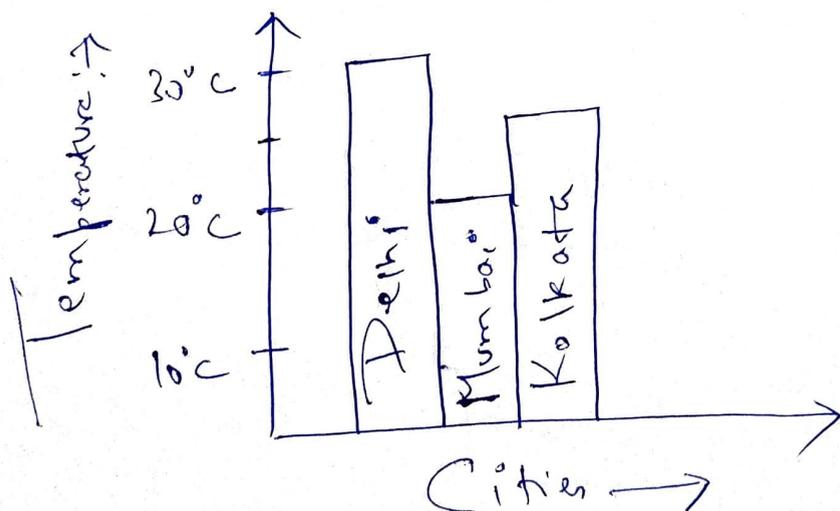
9 - LHT IIII , 10 - LHT LHT

2) Pie Chart or Chapati Chart

- It is in the form of a circle.
- Data is represented as a part of circles.



3) Bar Graph - This chart uses bar to represent data



4) Pictograph - In pictograph, we use pictures or symbols to represent data. A picture can have any

numerical value.

Ex :-

Days
Monday

Items Sold
#

Tuesday

=

Wednesday

= =

\rightarrow 50 items

= \rightarrow 10 items

Monday - $50 + 50 + 50 = 150$ items

Tuesday - $50 + 10 = 60$ items

Wednesday - $10 + 10$ items

Total items sold = 20 items.
