Q.4 This morning I had 90p. I spent 24p on a pencil and 34p on a notepad. How much do I now have left?





Q.6 Today Sally started reading a book which has 750 pages. She read 193 pages this morning and read 242 pages this afternoon. How many pages are left to read?




