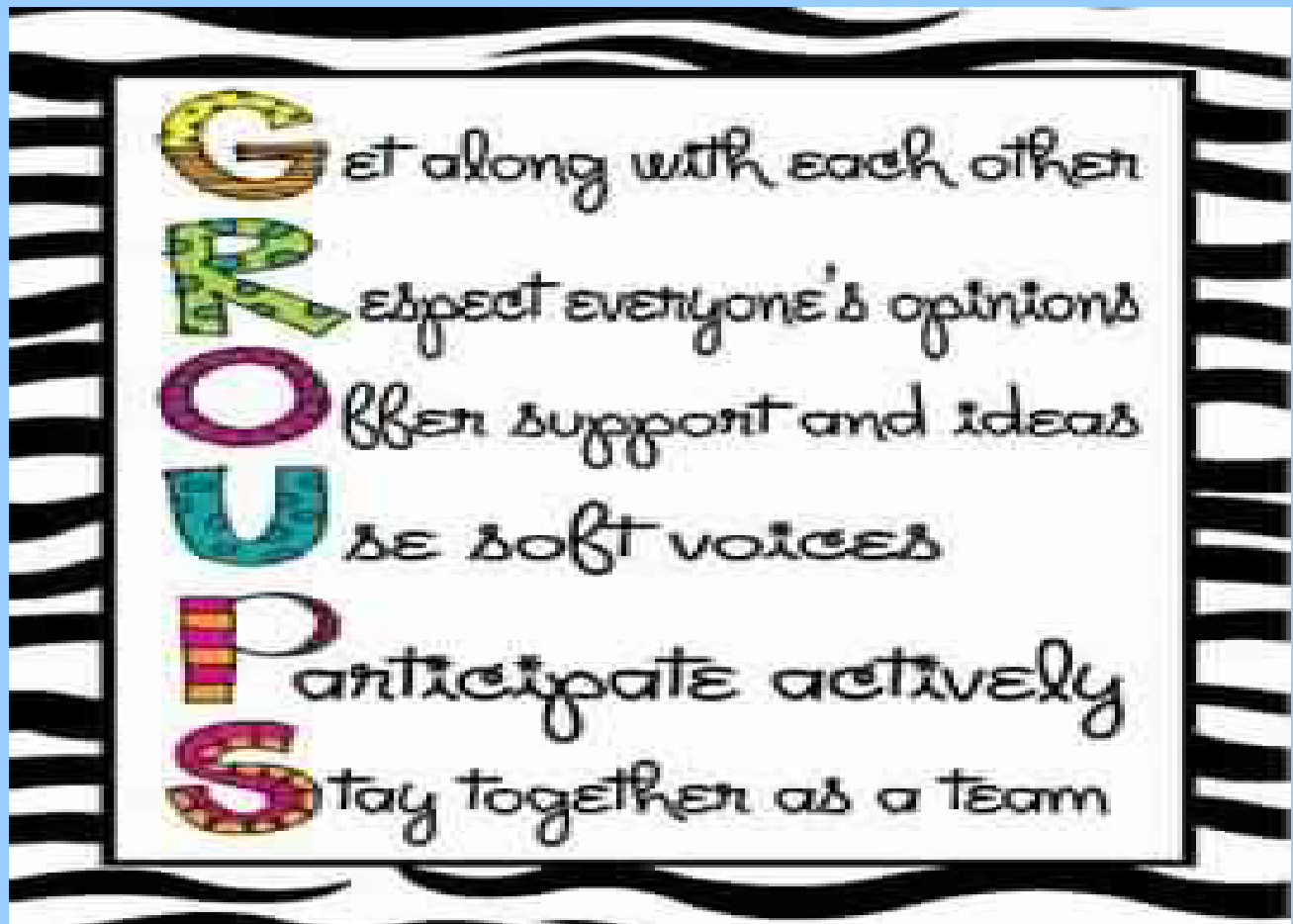
3rd stanza.....

Explanation of the 3rd stanza:

In the third stanza of the poem "Teamwork", the poetess describes the importance of teamwork and the benefits of working in a group. In this stanza, the poetess elaborates that a team consists of several members. Each member of a team is considered as one part and these parts form a whole or complete team. In a team, everyone will look for the common goal/ target. The poetess also says that teamwork can be a big plus when a you or a me becomes an us (forms a group).



Word meanings:

- a) **Part-** (Noun) a member of a team.
- b) **Whole-** (Noun) A thing that is complete in itself.
- c) **Common-** (Adjective) shared by or belonging to two or more people or by the people in a group.
- d) **Goal-** (Noun) Aim/Target.
- e) **Big-** (Adjective) Huge.
- f) **Plus-** (Noun) An advantage.
