Add a title with your description and write it in your own words.



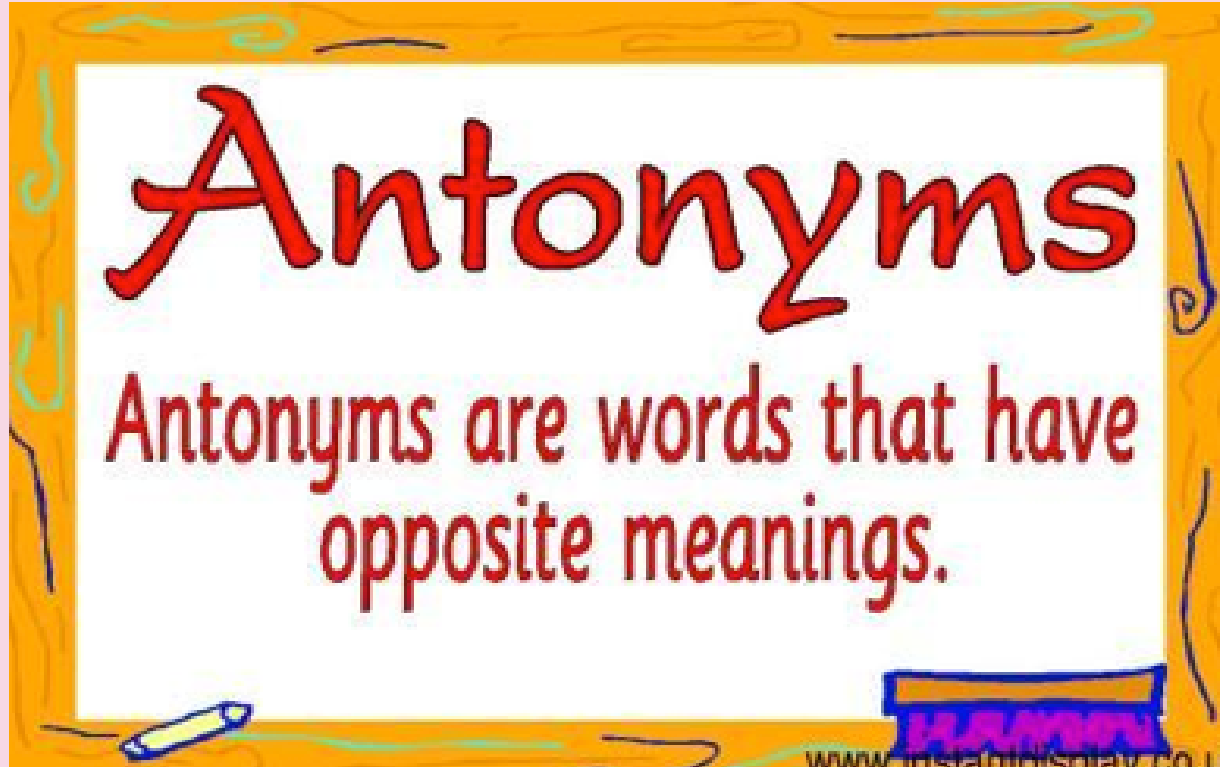
