1. A box contains apples and oranges. The total number of fruits is 365. If 126 of them are apples, then how many oranges does the box have?

SOLUTION...

H T O

Total no. of fruits = 3 6 5

No. of apples = - 1 2 6

No. of oranges = 2 3 9

Ans = The box have 239 oranges.

2. There are 534 cars in a parking lot. 249 drive away. How many cars are left in a parking lot?

SOLUTION...

H T O

Total no. of cars = 5 3 4

No. of cars drive away = - 2 4 9

No. of cars left = 2 8 5

Ans = 285 cars are left in a parking lot.
