There is a small tree nearby. It has a nest hanging from its branch. Birds are so wonderfully different. The crow builds its nest high up on a tree. The dove makes its nest among the thorns of a cactus plant or a *mehendi* hedge. The sparrow can be found in and around our own house. It makes its nest

anywhere – on top of a cupboard, behind a mirror, on a ledge. Pigeons also make their nest like this. Often they make nests in old or deserted buildings. The barbet or coppersmith bird can be heard in the summer with its 'tuk, tuk, tuk' call. It makes its nest in a hole, in a tree trunk. And the tailor bird uses its sharp

beak to stitch together two leaves on a bush. It lays its eggs in the fold of the leaf that it has made. This is its nest.
