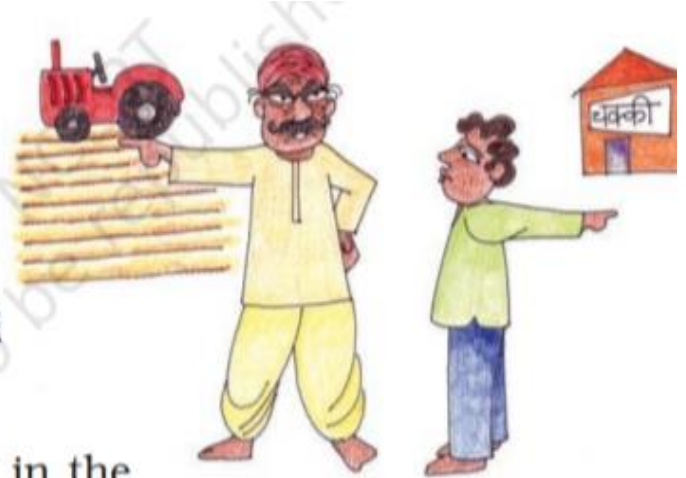


CASE STUDY ON FAMILY
