A notable space-scientist APJ Abdul Kalam was born on October 15,1931 at Rameswaram in Madras. His full name was Avul Pakir Jainulabdeen Abdul Kalam. He studied from St. Joseph's college, Tiruchirappalli and then from Madras Institute of Technology. In 2002, he became the president of India and remained on that prestigious chair upto 2007. He got the Bharat Ratna in 1997, the Padma Bhusan in 1981 and the Hoover medal in 2009. Unfortunately he left us forever on July 27,2015 at the age of 83.
