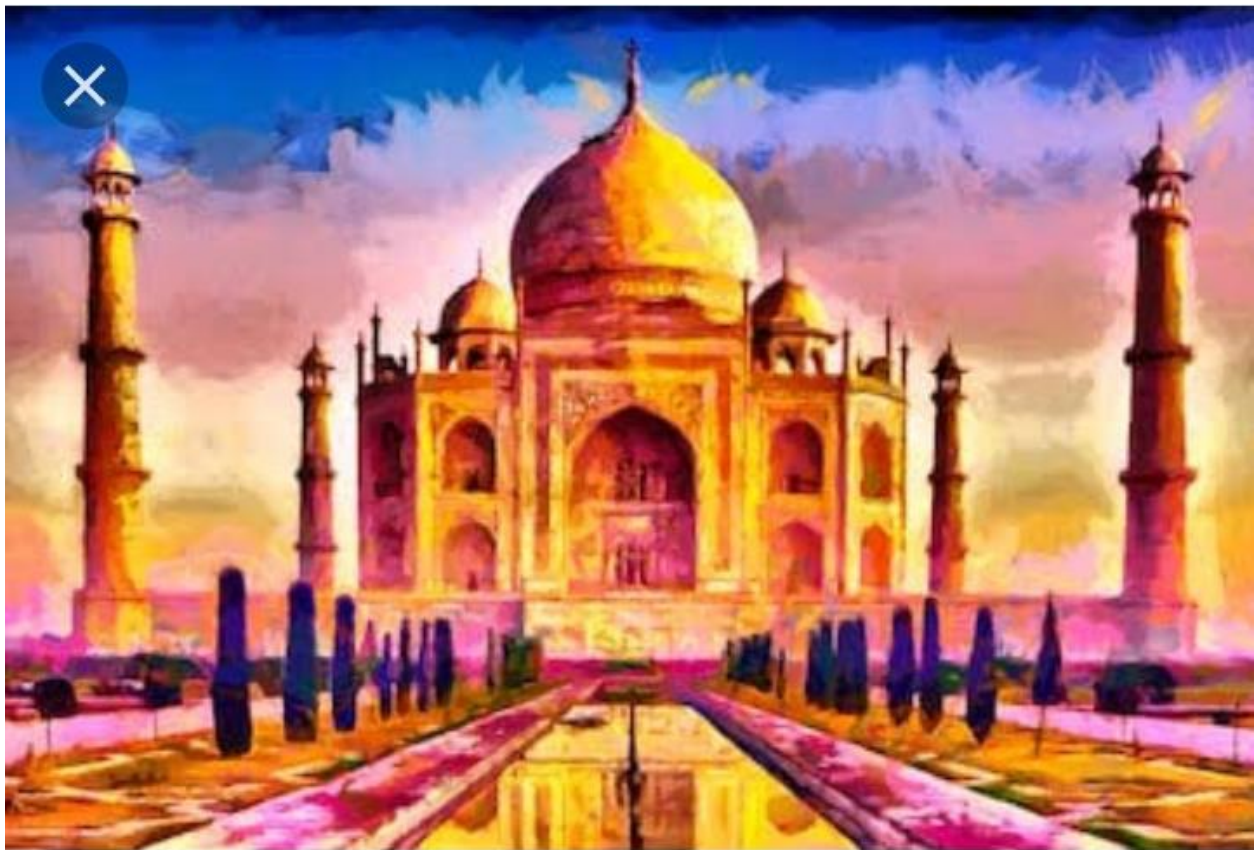
**India** has 38 world **heritage** sites that include 30 Cultural properties, 7 Natural properties and 1 mixed site.

Why it is important to protect our heritage?

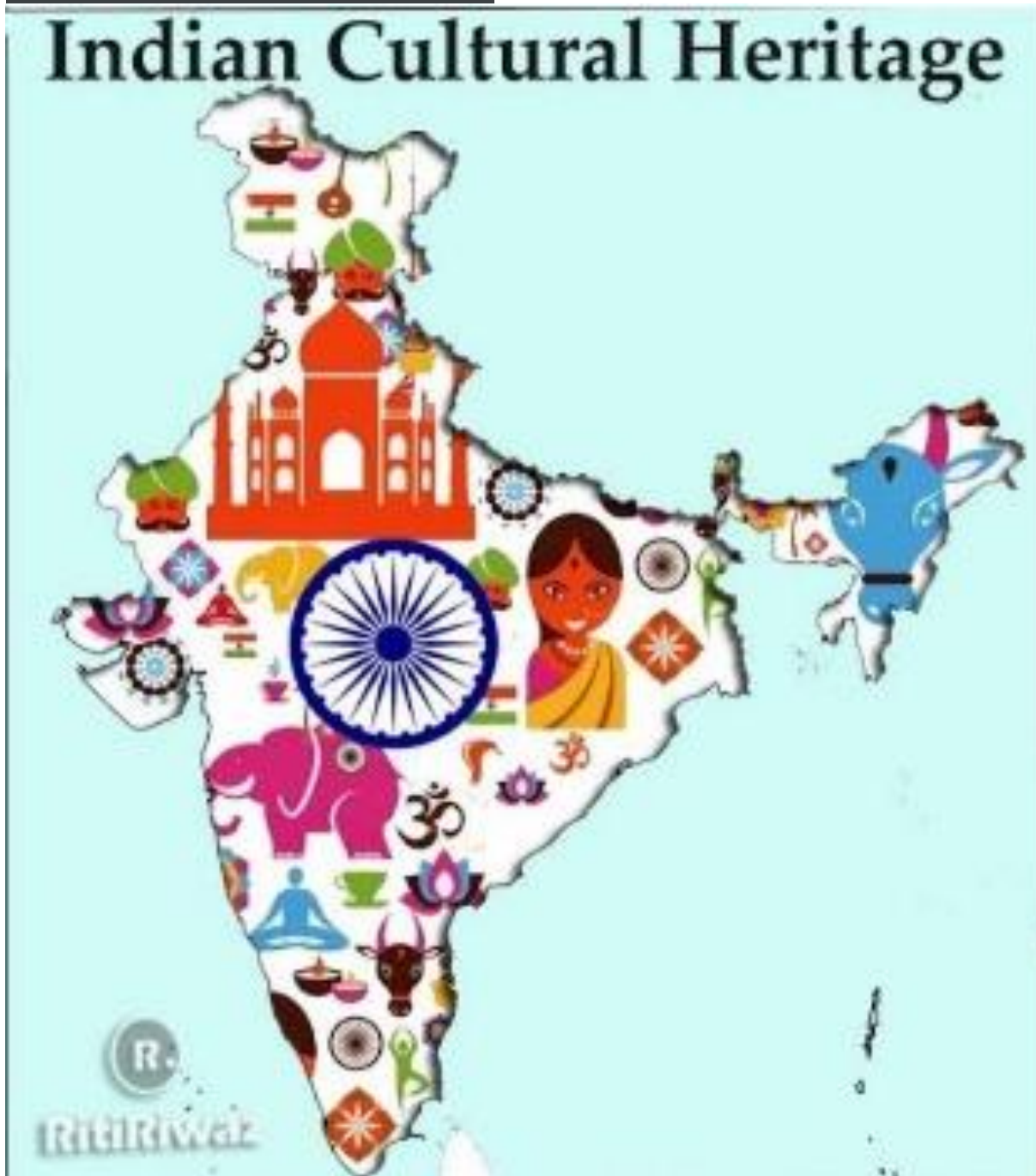
